Global State of Democracy Indices, 2020 edition: Provisional list of changes to the data set

The 2020 edition of the Global State of Democracy Indices (GSoDI) features 21 new indicators and one new data source, the <u>CIRights Data Project</u>. The CIRIGHTS Data project measures the strength of actual national government practices protecting human rights, using the coding guidelines developed by D. Cingranelli and D. Richards (Cingranelli et al. 2018; Cingranelli et al. 2014).

The inclusion of these new indicators has led to changes in the names of indicators. The following table shows all new indicators and all changes of indicator names in comparison with the current version of the GSoDI Codebook (V3, as of 2019). New versions of the Codebook, Methodology and Technical Procedures Guide are under preparation.
