# International IDEA, SUNGO, and WIBDI Launch IOE SAMOA Project Funded by the European Union

Apia, Samoa, 20 June 2024 – Today, International Institute for Democracy and Electoral Assistance (International IDEA), in collaboration with project partners Samoa Umbrella for Non-Governmental Organisations (SUNGO) and Women in Business Development Inc. (WIBDI), proudly launched the *Initiative on Empowerment of Civil Society in Democratic Samoa* (IOE SAMOA project). This initiative, generously funded (EUR 415 000) by the European Union, aims at supporting civil society organisations as actors of development and governance in the Pacific Island Countries.

The launch took place at the Millenia Hotel in Apia, Samoa, with the keynote speech delivered by the Ambassador of the European Union to the Pacific, Her Excellency Barbara Plinkert.

"The Civil Society Organizations are integral partners of the European Union in the Pacific that work on shared values and visions such as human development, peace and security. As such, we are proud to be able to support their work. Also under the Samoa Agreement, which is the newly signed Partnership Agreement between the European Union and the Organisation of African, Carribean and Pacific States, the signatories have agreed to cooperate towards the realization of human rights in the Pacific Region, including the strengthening of an enabling and safe environment for the active engagement of civil society thorough their capacity building. Therefore, the launch of the IOE SAMOA project today is a step in the right direction and I wish the partners a successful implementation", Ambassador Plinkert said.

Representing International IDEA, Leena Rikkilä Tamang, Regional Director for Asia and the Pacific, highlighted the project's aims to support Samoan civil society in advancing human rights, influencing policy and decision-making processes.

By empowering civil society, we are laying the foundation for sustainable development and democratic resilience.
