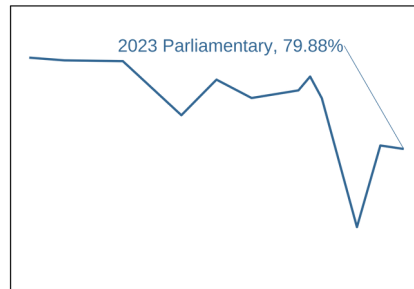

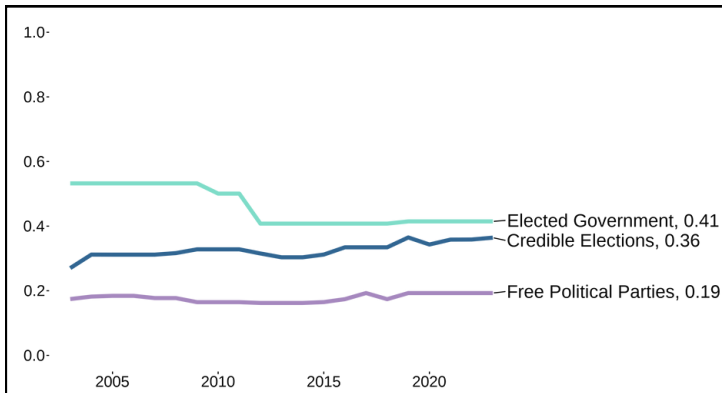

**Electoral system for lower/single chamber:**

Two-Round System

Extracted from the civil registry and checked by the CEC through door-to-door visits

Constitutional referendum to keep Mirziyoyev in power



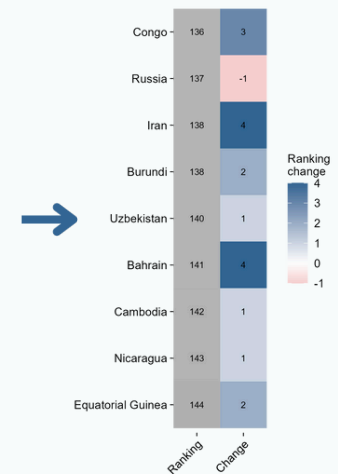
