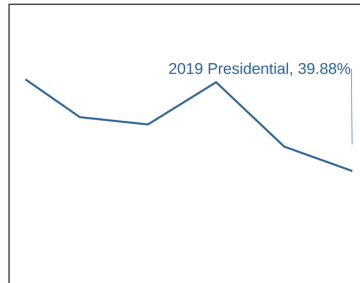

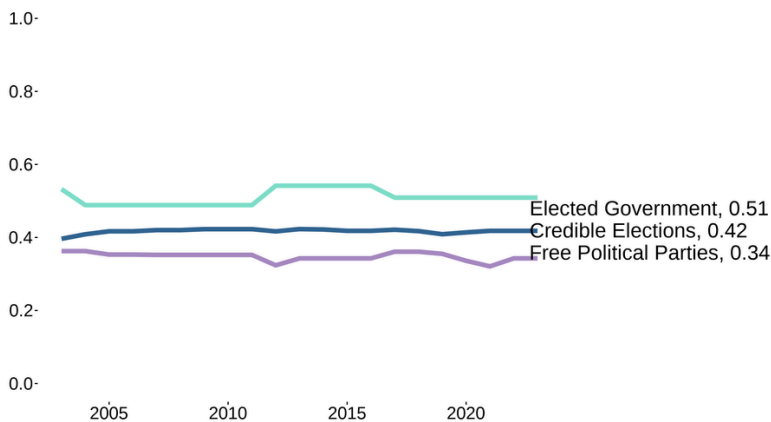

Direct election (two-round majority)

Algerians defy ban to support Palestinians, government detains Islamic Party leaders



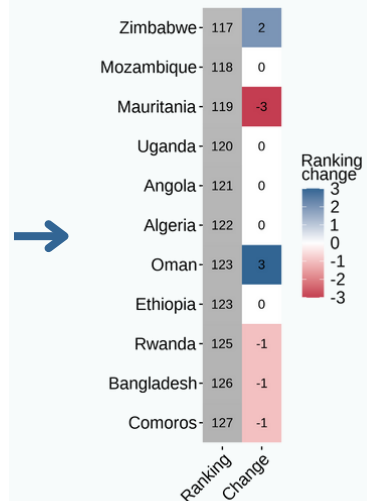
**August 2023**
